Meeting was opened by Chairman Rory MacGregor and thanks were given for those in attendance.

Everyone was given a copy of the Agenda for meeting.

1. Previous Minutes	Due to the fact that the minutes of the 7 September where scrutinised at the AGM the committee agreed there was no reason to go over them again. All attending agreed.

Richard Armstrong, countryside ranger has volunteered to instruct on building bat boxes. This could be a workshop taking place in the village hall. Roy to look at organising this for sometime in December 2009. Dave Bennett has had confirmation from the 'bat lady' that bat boxes constructed to date meet the required standards. Committee agreed to put this aside for the time being.
6. Activities	 Christmas tree & Lights Date proposed and agreed on was 17 December 2009. Lights will be switched on after carol singing. Proposal put forward to ask local business's to sponsor lights and Roy to draw up standard letter asking for sponsors. Gala 2010 Gala confirmed for Sunday 13th June 2010.
